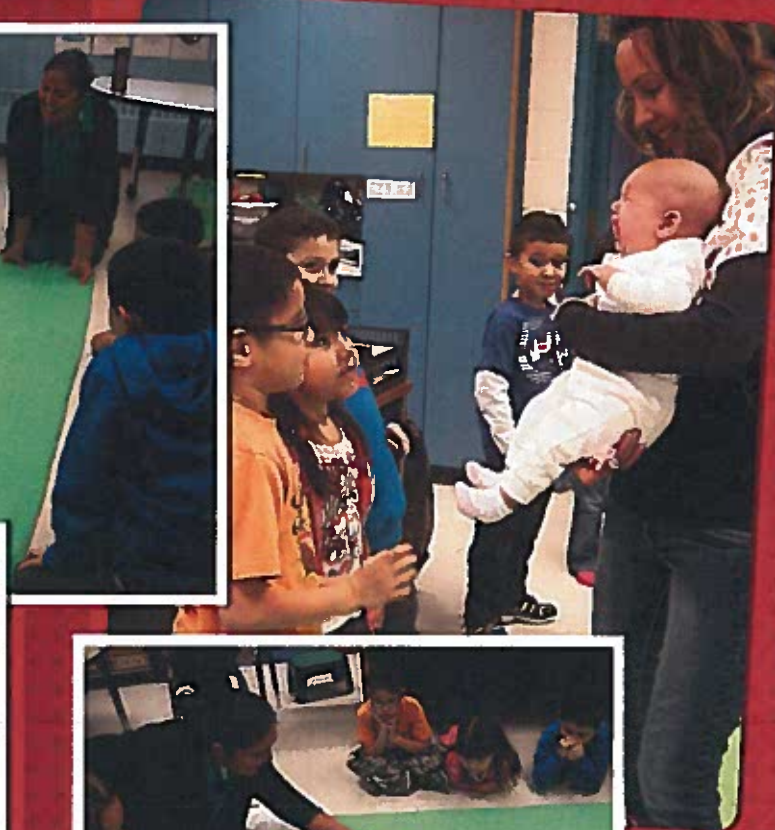

The Roots of Empathy Program is being delivered in the Grade 1 class. The children have 9 monthly visits from Miss Bethany and Baby Khalia and weekly classroom "Theme" Visits from Ms Shelley.

Roots of Empathy focuses on raising levels of empathy, resulting in more respectful and caring relationships and reduced levels of bullying and aggression.
